English as a Second Language
(ESL) Classes



Q. What do the Adult ESL classes provide?

- A. ☆ Opportunities for adults to develop English, reading, writing, and speaking skills.
- ☆ Opportunity to enter GED classes and study for GED test.
- ☆ Preparation for future education.
- ☆ Opportunity to learn about American culture and history.
- ☆ A no-cost opportunity to improve basic skills.

Q. Who may enroll in Adult ESL classes?

- A. ☆ Adults 19 years of age or older may call the Community Education Office at 801-3477 for further registration information.
- ☆ K-12 students are not eligible for Adult ESL classes unless officially withdrawn from school.

Q. When are Adult ESL classes held?

- A. The district offers sessions during the school year with each session lasting approximately 6 weeks.
- ☆ Session 1 begins the week of Monday, September 12, 2016
- ☆ Session 2 begins the week of Monday, October 24, 2016
- ☆ Session 3 begins the week of Monday, January 9, 2017
- ☆ Session 4 begins the week of Monday, February 27, 2017
- ☆ Session 5 begins the week of Monday, April 24, 2017

Registration and assessment are held the first week of each new session at 6:00 p.m. In that first week, the student **MUST** attend two evening classes to complete the registration and assessment.

Students are accepted only at the beginning of a session.

Q. What should the student bring to registration?

- A. A valid driver's license or valid picture ID is required to take classes.

Q. Where and when do Adult ESL classes take place?

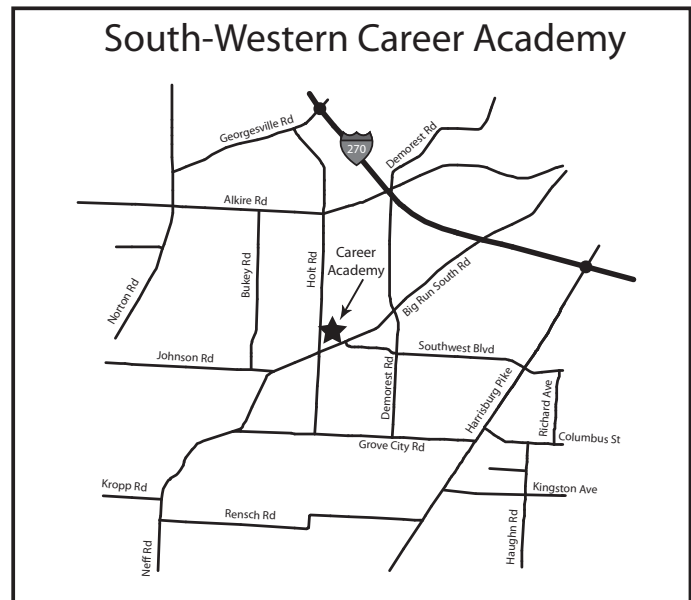
